TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Full details of materials/ equipments, including the Manufacturer's name and brand of the items must be mentioned whenever necessary.
2. The Federation does not bind itself to accept the lowest quotation and reserves the right of accepting or rejecting any quotation, in part or full, without assigning any reasons.
3. Date of delivery prescribed shall be deemed to be the " essence of the contract".
4. Quotations are required to be submitted with drawing/ specifications and submitted as such shall be deemed to mean that the bidder, submitting such a bid, is fully acquainted with the technical details.
5.
 - i) Bidders should furnish documents defining the constitution or legal status, place of registration and principal place of business of the company.
 - ii) Details of experience and past performance of the bidder on equipment offered and on those of similar nature within the past three years and details of current contracts in hand and other commitments.
 - iii) Major items of plant and machinery available/installed in the bidders factory premises.
 - iv) Qualification and experience of key personnel for successful execution of the contract.
 - v) Reports on financial standing of the bidder such as profit and loss statement, balance sheets and auditor's report of the past three years, bankers certificate, etc.
 - vi) Copies of CST/VAT/Service Tax Registration is to be furnished by the bidder.
 - vii) Information regarding any current litigation in which the bidder is involved.
6. The Federation shall not take the responsibility for any delay in receipt of the bidding documents.
7. The bidder shall indicate on the Price Schedule attached to these documents the unit prices and total bid prices of the goods it proposes to supply under the contract. To this end the bidders are allowed the option to submit bids for any one or more items specified in the schedule of requirements.

8. Price quoted by the bidder shall be fixed during the bidder's performance of the contract and not subject to variation on any account, for goods and services whose delivery schedule mentioned in the bidding document is 12 months or less. A bid submitted with an adjustable price quotation for such goods and services would be treated as non-responsive and rejected.
9. Bidders should clearly specify the percentage of discount offered by them.
10. The offer should be valid for a period of 120 days from the last date of receipt of the quotation.
11. All bids should be accompanied by an " Earnest Money Deposit" calculated at one percent of the quoted value, through Bank Draft drawn in favour of West Bengal Cooperative Milk Producers' Federation Limited payable at Kolkata, or through Bank Guarantee for similar amount as per format, given in Annexure III.
12. Our usual payment terms are
 - i. 30 % advance against receipt of clear acceptance copy of our order and a Bank Guarantee for an equivalent amount from a nationalized/ scheduled bank. Advance will be paid only when the order value exceeds Rs 5000 /-.
 - ii. 60 % on safe receipt of material at the delivery place.
 - iii. 10% within 30 days from the date of successful commissioning of plant/ equipment.

13. Security Deposit:

The Earnest Money deposited with the Tender shall be retained as initial Security Deposit. Subsequently, Security at 10% of the Order Value will be deducted from bills and would be released on expiry of Warranty/ Guarantee period. However, this may be released after commissioning on furnishing a performance security in the form of a Bank Guarantee for an equivalent amount, valid for 12 calendar months from the date of commissioning of for such period as applicable under the Warranty/ Guarantee clause. **Security deposits shall not carry any interest.**

14. The equipment to be supplied should be provided with Warranty /Guarantee for a period of 12 months after the goods are delivered and commissioned or for 18 months from the date of supply, whichever is earlier.
15. Force Majeure:

The terms and conditions mutually agreed upon shall be subject to force majeure. Neither the tenderer/ nor the employer shall be considered in default in the performance of its obligations

hereunder, if such performance is prevented or deleted because of war, hostilities, revolution, civil commotion, strike, accident, fire, wind, flood or because of any law, order proclamation, or ordinance of any government or any Act of God or of any other issue whether of similar or dissimilar nature, beyond the reasonable control of the party affected. Should one or both the parties prevented from fulfilling his/ their contractual obligation by a state of force majeure lasting continuously for a period of six months, the two parties should consult with each other regarding the future implementation of the agreement.

16. Liquidated Damages for Delay:

If the Contractor shall fail to achieve completion of the works within the time prescribed in the Purchase/ Work Order, then the contractor shall pay to the WBCMPFL the sum at the rate of $\frac{1}{2}$ % of the amended up to date Contract value as liquidated damages for such default and not as a penalty for every week or part of the week which shall elapse between the time prescribed within tender/ quotation and the date of certified completion of the particular works. The WBCMPFL may without prejudice to any other method of recovery, deduct the amount of such damages from any payment in its hands, due or which may become due to the Contractor. The payment or deduction of such damages shall not relieve the Contractor from his obligation to complete the works, or from any other of his obligations and liabilities under the contract.

The aggregate maximum of the liquidated damages payable to the WBCMPFL under this clause shall be subject to a maximum of 10% of the amended Contract value.

If, before the completion of the whole of the works, any part or section of the works has been certified by the Engineer as completed, and, occupied by the Owner/ WBCMPFL, the liquidated damages for delay shall, for any period of delay after such certificate be reduced in the proportion which the value of the part or section so certified bears to the value of the whole of the Works.

The criteria for deriving the liquidated damage shall be the actual value of works executed and the amended time of completion.

17. The Federation reserves the right to place order either in part or in full.
